## **EX-OFFICIO COMMENTS:**

Ex-Officio Member Schultz reported that the Jefferson Union High School District would be having an H1N1 vaccination clinic on 1-30-10. The vaccinations will be administered at Serramonte Del Ray High School. The vaccinations are open to the general public and there will not be a charge.

Ex Officio Member Lancell reported that the City of Pacifica would be forming a Climate Change Committee that will be responsible for interacting with the City of Pacifica

council on climate control issues. It was suggested that a member of Emergency Preparedness & Safety Commission be part of this new committee.

**STAFF COMMENTS:**

Captain Realyvasquez stated he would be meeting with Matt Lucett to finalize a location for the upcoming Silver Dragon Exercise on March 11, 2010. The exercise will be similar to the Silver Dragon exercise conducted last year and will be a joint exercise with Daly City. Captain Realyvasquez will be trying to determine how many CERT members will be able to commit to participation on this exercise in the next couple of weeks.

Captain Realyvasquez will be working to issue all CERT members their identification cards. CERT members who do not have identification cards will be invited to the police station on 2-17-10 to be issued their cards and meet the City of Pacifica Emergency Preparedness & Safety Commission.

On 1-25-10 representatives from the National Weather Service and Cal Fema will be coming to the police department to review and certify the City of Pacifica's Storm Ready protocols.

On 1-20-10 Daly City Fire set up their ECC in preparation of a severe storm warning. The expected storm did not materialize and there were no major issues.

Captain Realyvasquez reported that he spoke with the County OES about not being notified of the recent earthquake near Oregon. He also stated that there was no notification about the tornado warning today but that was because it was for Santa Clara County.

Sergeant Londerville reported that the City of Pacifica would conduct a tabletop earthquake exercise on 4-21-10 involving all City of Pacifica departments. The exercise will focus on communication and that will involve the CERT personnel, amateur radio operators and public schools.
