**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA  
PROCLAIMING TERMINATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY AT THE SEWER MAIN  
LOCATED NEAR 700 PALMETTO AVENUE**

**RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Pacifica, California, that

**WHEREAS**, a local emergency existed in Pacifica in accordance with the proclamation thereof by the Director of Emergency Services on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2021 and its ratification by the City Council on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August, 2021 as a result of conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property discovered by Public Works Wastewater Division staff which approximately an eighty feet section of the 12-inch sewer main near 700 Palmetto Avenue to be sagging and corroded; and

**WHEREAS**, these conditions of the damaged 12-inch sewer main in danger of collapsing would create a hazardous condition including potential Sanitary Sewer Overflows and threaten the safety of persons and property, including critical public infrastructure; and


**WHEREAS**, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of and within Pacifica; and


**NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of Pacifica, State of California, does hereby proclaim the termination of said local emergency.


