RESOLUTION NO. 73-2021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY, FULL-TIME COMMUNITY SERVICE OFFICER POSITION IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR UNHOUSED LIAISON SERVICES AND OVERSIZED VEHICLE ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT

WHEREAS, the City will be developing and implementing a new safe parking permit program in conjunction with the City's enforcement of the City's Oversized Vehicle Ordinance, which regulates parking of oversized vehicles; and

WHEREAS, this temporary position will be responsible for providing unhoused liaison services and enforcing the Oversized Vehicle Ordinance throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the job description for Community Service Officer has been in place since April 1999 and reviewed by staff and found to be accurate and appropriate for the duties assigned; and

WHEREAS, the Community Service Officer position will be a full-time, temporary, non-sworn position, managed within the Police Department and serve a variety of functions related to unhoused liaison services and oversized vehicles including, but not limited to the following:

- Communicate with the unhoused and those living in oversized vehicles to provide connection to outreach resources related to the Pacifica Resource Center, mental health services and substance abuse services;
- Regular meetings with the Pacifica Resource Center to maintain a positive stream of communication, assuring those desiring unhoused services are aware of how to receive these services;
- Coordinate with Code Enforcement and Police Department staff related to criminal or serious health and safety issues;
- Collaborate with Public Works staff related to debris clean-up related to oversized vehicles and encampments; and

WHEREAS, the Community Service Officer position shall also serve a variety of functions related to enforcement including, but not be limited to, the following:

- Enforcement of the Oversized Vehicle Ordinance
- Enforcement of the 72-hour parking ordinance, relating to oversized vehicles
- Enforcement of health and safety regulations pertaining to trash, sewage and other hazardous materials related to oversized vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the established salary range for the position of Community Service Officer is \$5,325 to \$6,336 per month; and

WHEREAS, the position is temporary and expected to expire after one-year but may be continued for an additional year contingent on annual funding approval.
