

CITY OF PACIFICA OPEN SPACE & PARKLAND ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Minutes of November 18, 2015

In attendance were members Jim Sullivan, Noel Blincoe, George Frank, JoAnne Arnos, Julie Lancelle, Paul Jones, Mike Pacelli, new member Ron Maykel, City Council Liaison Sue Digre and staff liaison Kathryn Farbstein. Chair Alison Sanders and GGNRA liaison Christine Fitzgerald were absent.

CALL TO ORDER:

Co-Chair Jim Sullivan called the meeting to order at 6:01. He welcomed Ron Maykel as a new member of the OSPAC Committee.

ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:

Approval of Order of Agenda

The order of the agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes of September 16, 2015

The approval of the minutes was approved 7-1-1, with Alison Sanders absent, and new member Ron Maykel abstaining.

Committee Communications:

Noel discussed the OSPAC Resolution, scheduled to be on the City Council Agenda on November 23. He also spoke about the previous review of the property formerly known as The Prospects. He said that it is important that the OSPAC Committee be involved in reviewing the new project because of bordering HPD lands. JoAnne talked about the hummingbird garden, picnic area and the trail aspects of the new project. Staff liaison Kathryn Farbstein reminded the committee that detailed discussion about the project should not take place at this time.

George mentioned an article about the quarry, specifically relating to removing non-native plants and a future community planting day. He thought this would be a good project for the OSPAC Committee to be involved in. Ron noted that the reason for removal of plants is due to a culvert pipe.

Jim thanked Paul for the hard work he has put into getting materials prepared for the quarry site.

JoAnne said that she simply wants to see the OSPAC Committee more involved. The group discussed putting the quarry on the agenda, once approval of the resolution takes place. Paul said that since the OSPAC Committee

generally does not meet in December, he would like staff liaison Tina Wehrmeister to ask the quarry owner to come to the OSPAC meeting in January.

Noel commented the Preservation Award, and stated that he feels this should be on the January or February agenda as well.
