COUNCIL LIASION COMMENTS:

Although there was no quorum, Mayor Pro Tem Bigstycck spoke to the commission on several topics. He spoke about the three recent hate crime incidents that have taken place at local Pacifica schools. Mayor Pro Tem Bigstycck talked about an upcoming rally and candle light vigil to denounce these acts and show solidarity against hate. Mayor Pro Tem Bigstycck talked about how a proposed ½ cent sales tax will be on the November ballot. This tax is in being proposed due to a projected \$2.7 million dollar budget deficient the city in the coming year. He also spoke about the General Plan update that the city has completed. This has been a 13-year project.

Mayor Pro Tem Bigstycck attended a North County Fire Authority meeting which talked about Pacifica continuing to be a part of the Authority. The Daly City Fire Department and the Brisbane Fire Department also make up the fire authority. He spoke to the commission about his concern about recent traffic collisions on Fassler Avenue and Manor Drive. On August 18, 2022 the Pacifica City Council will hold a meeting that will focus on traffic safety in these areas.

Mayor Pro Tem Bigstycck briefly spoke about the return of the Pacific Coast Fog Fest in September.
