In attendance was Chair Patton, Vice Chair Arnos, McDermod, Lancelle, Goodmiller, Natesan, and Skaggs. Cardona and Read were absent. Staff Liaison O'Connor was also present.

CALL TO ORDER: Chair Patton called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS:

Roll Call A quorum was confirmed.

Approval of Order of Agenda. Unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes of September 21, 2022 Unanimously approved.

PRESENTATION:

Introduction of new committee members Lauren Goodmiller, Amanda Skaggs, and Ian McDermod – Goodmiller, Skaggs, and McDermod all introduced themselves to the committee, existing committee members also provided an introduction.

PUBLIC COMMUNICATIONS:

Oral Communications – None.

Committee Communications – *Natesan* informed the committee that she is now the Pacifica Land Trust liaison for OSPAC. *Arnos* said that the applicant for 570 Crespi would like to present to OSPAC.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS:

- **1. Update by GGNRA/GGNPC** *Darren Brown (GGNRA)* provided an update about a property analysis that GGNRA is conduction on Rancho Corral De Tierra to increase public access and invited OSPAC to participate in that effort. *Brown* also updated the committee on the Mori Point/Moose Lodge Parking pilot program which is slated to occur in Spring 2023.
- 2. Update by City Council Liaison None.

STAFF COMMUNICATIONS:

3. Development project updates – *O'Connor* provided updates on the Quarry Reclamation Plan and 570 Crespi.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

4. Review and receive inputs for OSPAC workplan. The committee discussed the work plan including added items and assigning tasks to committee members. *Paul Jones (public)* suggested to the committee that they partner with a larger entity to get grant funding.

- 5. Discuss forming an OSPAC-led volunteer effort to maintain Ahni Trail at Cattle Hill. Committee discussed the need for maintenance to occur along the Ahni Trail. *Paul Jones* identified that the following tasks which can be done with a group of volunteers: establish a workday, fix waterbars with hand tools, get liability release form from City, cut social trails, and investigate NCCWD easement on the City's property. Subcommittee was unanimously approved to include *McDermod, Skaggs, Patton, and Goodmiller*
- **6. Vote to add members to Funding Subcommittee.** Unanimously approved to add *Cardona* and *Lancelle* to funding committee (*Patton* and *Read* are existing members).
- 7. Confirm cancellation of December 21, 2022 OSPAC Meeting. O'Connor confirmed that the December OSPAC meeting will be cancelled due to unavailable staff support as a result of the Christmas holiday.

ADJOURNMENT *Patton* adjourned the meeting at 7:37 pm.

Pacifica Preservation Award

Nomination Process and Selection Criteria

- 1. Awardees will be individuals or groups who have contributed to preserving or maintaining Pacifica's open spaces, parklands or other areas adjacent to Pacifica.
- 2. Awardee will not be a member of OSPAC.
- 3. Awardees will be nominated by members of the public as well as OSPAC committee members
- 4. Awardees will be voted on by OSPAC members by secret ballot.
- 5. OSPAC will award one Preservation award per year.
- 6. Awardees will not be eligible for future Preservation awards.
- 7. Nominations should be received in writing by OSPAC by the date set forth by the committee.
- 8. Nominees may be nominated for the award again if they didn't previously win but names will not carry over the subsequent year. Nominees must be re-nominated by either committee members or members of the public.
- 9. OSPAC will sent a thank you letter to the person who submitted the nomination, thanking them for their time and nomination.

We didn't get into details about the proclamation as that will be unique to every awardee.
