## **RESOLUTION NO. 16-2018**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA ADOPTING THE LIST OF PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED BY THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017 SB 1 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pacifica must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1 by resolution, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pacifica, will receive and estimated \$676,429 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2018-19 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the second year in which the City of Pacifica is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City of Pacifica to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pacifica has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pacifica used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of Pacifica maintain and rehabilitate two busy arterial roads, construct new sidewalks and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the City this year and numerous similar projects into the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pacifica Pavement Management System found that the City's streets and roads are in an "poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "fair" condition; and

**WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the City Council of the City of Pacifica, State of California, as follows:

The FY 2017-18 Pavement Rehabilitation Project will rehabilitate the pavement along Linda Mar Boulevard from Adobe Drive to Alicante Drive and Oceana Boulevard from Milagra Drive to Monterey Road by placing 2 inches of asphalt overlay. This project will also include pavement grinding for base repair as well as installation of thermoplastic traffic

striping, markings, and pavement markers.
