A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE ULTRAVIOLET (UV) DISINFECTION EQUIPMENT FOR THE CALERA CREEK WATER RECYCLING PLANT RELATED TO THE UV DISINFECTION REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the Capital Improvement Program 2022-2027 at the June 27, 2022 Council Meeting which included the Ultraviolet Disinfection Replacement Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, during the FY 2022-23 budget approval process, the City Council approved sufficient funding on Ultraviolet (UV) Disinfection Equipment for the Project; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the City of Pacifica's Purchasing Policy (Administrative Policy No. 76), the City of Pacifica advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) to Purchase UV Disinfection Equipment for the Calera Creek Water Recycling Plant related to the Project in February of 2023; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the State Public Contracts Code, the RFP utilized a qualifications-based selection (QBS) approach to ensure the City selected the most qualified vendor to furnish UV Disinfection Equipment for this complex and critical Project; and

WHEREAS, the highest ranking vendor was Trojan Technologies; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pacifica to authorize the City Manager to execute an Agreement with Trojan Technologies in the amount of \$1,136,603.75 for Ultraviolet Disinfection Equipment in connection to the Ultraviolet Disinfection Replacement Project and approve budget authority in the amount of \$1,250,264.13 which includes 10% contingency in the amount of \$113,660.38; and authorize the City Manager to execute all documents related to the project equipment purchase.
