The Pacifica Resource Beach Parking Pass is Now Available

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (Pacifica, CA) – The City of Pacifica Parks, Beaches and Recreation Department, in collaboration with the Pacifica Resource Center, and in cooperation with the California Coastal Commission, is proud to present the new **Pacifica Resource Beach Parking Pass**. This pass is available to any qualifying person on a limited income who meets the eligibility requirements.

Eligibility can be established by providing one of the following forms of proof:

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI)
- Medi-Cal
- Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card
- Calfresh
- SFMTA (Low Income)
- Lifeline Pass [YMCA membership assistance](#)
- Lyft Bay Wheels
