

RESOLUTION NO. 91-2023

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE  
COMMUNITY LEASING PARTNERS TO FINANCE A NEW FRONT LINE FIRE ENGINE

**WHEREAS**, one new fire engine is needed to replace aging vehicles in the fleet and current estimated time of order to delivery of new fire engines is 3 years to 4 years, which necessitates acquisition at this time; and

**WHEREAS**, the industry standard and lifespan for fire apparatus is 10 years front line service and 5-10 years reserve service the City has a front-line fire engine and a reserve fire engine that exceed the industry standard and necessitate replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, benefits of having an up-to-date fleet results in less downtime, reduction in maintenance costs, eliminates inability to procure replacement parts, provides for operational readiness and performance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved a replacement of the front-line Fire Engine through lease purchase financing as part of the FY 2023-24 Adopted Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Pacifica, California, to authorize the City Manager to execute the lease financing agreement with Community Leasing Partners to purchase a front-line fire engine in need of replacement and execute all necessary documents related to this purchase.


