A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PACIFICA AND TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC FOR MUNIS ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING (ERP) SYSTEM AND IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City's current Finance System, GEMS, which supports all finance and payroll functions, was purchased in 2008, and utilizes outdated software technology, making it increasingly difficult to maintain; and

WHEREAS, with the technical assistance of the project consultant Client First, City staff issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) System and Implementation Services and received five qualified responses; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technology, Inc. demonstrated that the proprietary software product Munis ERP can meet the City's needs without the need for customizations; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technology, Inc. has agreed to perform the services related to Munis ERP implementation as outlined in the Exhibit A Investment Summary in the contract for the City at a cost not to exceed \$666,550. This includes a one-time fee of \$239,660 from remote implementation and data conversion, as well as a locked annual subscription of \$85,378 for the next five years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pacifica, California, to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Tyler Technologies, Inc for the Munis Enterprise Resource Planning Solution.
