A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA
APPROVING THE PURCHASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF PACIFICA
AND PAN-PACIFIC SUPPLY TO REBUILD THE P20 PRIME PUMP AND EPOXY COAT
THE HYDRAFLO PUMP FOR THE LINDA MAR STORMWATER PUMP STATION
REHABILITATION PROJECT AND REBUILD THE FAIRBANKS MORSE PUMP AND
GE VERTICAL MOTOR FOR THE LINDA MAR PUMP STATION REHABILITATION AND
REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, during the FY 2023-24 Capital Improvements Program (CIP) budget approval process, the City Council approved funding for the Linda Mar Stormwater Pump Station Rehabilitation Project and the Linda Mar Pump Station Rehabilitation and Repair Project (Projects); and

WHEREAS, the Projects includes the rehabilitation or rebuild or epoxy coating of existing pumps; and

WHEREAS, Staff compared the costs of replacing these pumps to the costs of rebuilding and determined that the costs to rebuild will only be about 20% to 30% compared to the costs of total replacement. Moreover, the lead time for the new pumps will be at least eight months to one year; and

WHEREAS, because time of is of the essence, staff started soliciting quotes from different pump repair companies that will guarantee completion of the work before the rainy season begin. Only Pan-Pacific Supply gave staff the time and assurance that the pumps will be delivered in a much better condition by the end of October 2023; and

WHEREAS, City of Pacifica Administrative Policy #76, Purchasing Policy, section 3.6.1, authorizes the City Manager to waive bidding requirements for urgent procurement if he/she determines sufficient justification exists.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pacifica to:

Approve the Purchase Agreement between the City of Pacifica and Pan-Pacific Supply, via urgent purchase, in the amount of \$93,987.40 to rebuild the P20 Prime Pump and Epoxy coat Hydraflo Pump for the Linda Mar Stormwater Pump Station Rehabilitation Project and rebuild the Fairbanks Morse pump and GE Vertical motor for the Linda Mar Pump Station Rehabilitation and Replacement Project and authorize the City Manager to execute all documents related to the purchase authorize the City Manager to execute all documents related to the purchase.
