

RESOLUTION NO. 46-2017

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA RESCINDING
RESOLUTION #64-2016 AND EXTENDING THE SUNSET DATE OF THE ILLEGAL
FIREWORKS TASK FORCE**

WHEREAS, the City of Pacifica desires to examine options related to eliminating the use of illegal fireworks in the City; and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2016 the City Council adopted Resolution #64-2016, establishing an Illegal Fireworks Task Force, which is set to sunset on March 20, 2018, one year after the first publicly noticed meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Illegal Fireworks Task Force developed enforcement strategies to combat illegal fireworks and public outreach strategies to educate and deter people from possessing and using illegal fireworks, which were accepted by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the accepted enforcement and public outreach strategies were implemented during the weeks leading up to and including July 4th, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the use of illegal fireworks continued to be a problem in Pacifica on July 4, 2017; and

WHEREAS, communications between community members and the Police Department significantly increased due to community outreach efforts; and

WHEREAS, staff and the Illegal Fireworks Task Force desire to continue their efforts into the 2018 July 4th season;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Pacifica, California, does hereby rescind Resolution #64-2016 and extends the sunset date of the Illegal Fireworks Task Force to August 31, 2018.


