RESOLUTION NO. 15-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF
UNDERSTANDING WITH THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO SUPPORTING
PACIFICA RESOURCE CENTER'S EDIBLE FOOD RECOVERY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorized the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's (state) efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in December of 2021, the City Council adopted an Ordinance titled "Mandatory Organic Waste Disposal" to comply with state-mandated regulations surrounding SB 1383; and

WHEREAS, in April of 2022, the City received a grant of \$54,428 from CalRecycle for implementation of SB 1383 with the City contributing \$26,918.78 from the grant to the County of San Mateo to help with the City's SB 1383 implementation requirements and keeping \$27,509.22 for procurement of mulch and compost; and

WHEREAS, the City does not have the space to store the large quantity of mulch/compost that would be needed to use the remainder of the grant by the grant deadline of May 2, 2024, and desires to transfer the surplus of \$19,052.55 of to the County of San Mateo for their use to support PRC's Edible Food Recovery Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager must enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of San Mateo for this fund transfer to occur;

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Pacifica authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the County of San Mateo supporting Pacifica Resource Center's Edible Food Recovery Program through the transfer of \$19,052.55 in CalRecycle 2022 grant funds to the County.
