A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 MID-YEAR BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the FY 2023-24 Operating and Capital Budget on June 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Adopted FY2023-24 budget was a balanced expenditure plan that ensured the maintenance of adequate reserves; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has completed a midyear budget review to validate budget assumptions and conduct an analysis of the year-to-date revenues and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the Mid-Year Budget analysis and requested budget adjustments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pacifica now desires to adopt the FY 2023-24 Mid-Year adjustments to the FY 2023-24 budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES: The City Council of the City of Pacifica hereby approves the mid-year adjustments to the FY 2023-24 budget:

Section 2. The CIP Budget is amended to include additional appropriations for Sharp Park PDA Pedestrian Improvement, Civic Center, Priority Parks, and Anza Pump Station Repair projects as requested at the midyear budget review, and include the corresponding increase in the construction contingency for two projects:

- a) Increase the Civic Center contingency by \$150,000, or 1% of the construction budget, to a total contingency of \$1,387,838, or 12.6%, which will increase the total project construction budget authority to \$10,801,966.
- b) Increase the Anza Pump contingency by \$113,278, or 4% of the construction budget, to a total contingency of \$806,611, or 35%, which will increase the total project construction budget authority to \$3,132,611.
