

RESOLUTION NO. 98-2024

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA
APPROVING NEWLY ESTABLISHED AND ADJUSTED FEES FOR USE OF COMMUNITY
CENTER, CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS AND CIVIC CENTER AND AMENDING THE CITY OF
PACIFICA MASTER FEE AND CHARGES SCHEDULE, ATTACHED TO ADMINISTRATIVE
POLICY NO. 2, TO INCORPORATE THOSE FEES**

WHEREAS, Administrative Policy 2 sets forth procedures for the review and approval of City fees and charges; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2024, the City Council of the City of Pacifica passed and adopted Resolution No. 61-2024 amending Administrative Policy 2, the Master Fee and Charges Schedule as set forth in Exhibit A attached thereto; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to repeal, replace and rename Administrative Policy No. 3 from "Regulations for Use of City Council Chambers" to "Public Use of the Community Center, Civic Center and City Council Chambers" to address use of spaces in these buildings for public use following the completion of the renovation of the Pacifica Civic Center; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update existing fees related to the use of Community Center spaces and establish new fees related to the use of the Community Center, Civic Center and City Council Chamber spaces in coordination with the updated Administrative Policy No. 3; and

WHEREAS, under the Parks, Beaches & Recreation section of the Master Fee and Charges Schedule in Exhibit A of Administrative Policy No. 2, the City desires to adopt and incorporate the fees as indicated in Attachment B; and

WHEREAS, staff has determined that the proposed fees are needed to cover staff time and City costs incurred in allowing for the public use of spaces within the Community Center, Civic Center and City Council Chambers and to be consistent with regional standards and priority group categories as set forth in Administrative Policy No. 3;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pacifica, California, that it hereby adopts the following fees and charges which reflect the reasonable costs of providing for the public use of the Community Center, Civic Center and City Council Chamber spaces for which the fee is charged as indicated in Attachment B; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby amends the Parks, Beaches & Recreation section within Exhibit A, "Master Fee and Charges Schedule," to Administrative Policy No. 2 to incorporate the foregoing fees, as indicated in Attachment B, attached hereto; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any fees and charges that have been previously adopted by resolution and are not being modified in Attachment A, are incorporated in Attachment A for ease of reference only and without modifying or amending such fees or the underlying approvals in any manner.


