CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN ACTIONS TO IMPLEMENT AN AFFORDABLE HOUSING REGULATORY AGREEMENT between Pacifica Villages, LP and the City of Pacifica, approved by the City Council on November 23, 2020, to convert Marymount Summit/Gateway Apartments located at 405-439 and 443-467 Gateway Drive in Pacifica (APNs 009-540-110, -120, -130, -140, -150, -160, and -170) into an affordable housing project with new residents restricted to incomes of 80 percent of the San Mateo County Area Median Income (AMI) or less. The actions being considered by the City Council to implement the Affordable Housing Regulatory Agreement will include but not necessarily be limited to approval of the proposed property management agent for the apartment complex, The John Stewart Company, as well as authorizing certain actions to terminate existing condominiums on the property.
