City Council To Consider Appointment of Kevin S. Woodhouse as City Manager at Regular Meeting on September 11, 2017

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (Pacifica, CA) 6 September 2017 -

At its September 11, 2017 meeting, the Pacifica City Council will be considering the adoption of a resolution appointing Kevin S. Woodhouse as City Manager of the City of Pacifica and approving an Employment Agreement with Mr. Woodhouse. Following a formal recruitment process, Kevin S. Woodhouse has been identified by the Council as the candidate most qualified to perform the duties of City Manager.

Kevin Woodhouse has worked in local government for 27 years. He is currently the Assistant General Manager – Visitor and Field Services for the Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District and previously worked for the City of Mountain View as its Deputy City Manager. In his roles with the City of Mountain View and Midpen Open Space, Mr. Woodhouse has gained a wide array of experience in areas such as budget development and finance having managed a 10-Year Financial Forecast and Economic Development study and helping develop long-term fiscal sustainability strategies. Mr. Woodhouse also oversaw the human resources function for Midpen Open Space and helped develop and lead the organization's annual strategic planning and goal setting process. In addition to the above, Mr. Woodhouse is also experienced in labor negotiations, inter-agency partnerships, public affairs, governmental transparency and ethics, open space land restoration and management and environmental stewardship and regulatory compliance. Mr. Woodhouse graduated from Stanford University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Philosophy and then from San Francisco State University with a Masters of Public Administration.

If the Council appoints Mr. Woodhouse as City Manager and approves his Employment Agreement on September 11, 2017, his employment with the City would begin on October 9, 2017.
