COMMISSION COMMUNICATIONS:

Commissioner Bigstyck stated that he wanted to remind everyone to wear masks as the rates were going up, and while he didn't think it was as bad in our area and they are optimistically seeing potential vaccines in the not too distant future. He then mentioned that this was probably his last Planning Commission meeting as a commissioner as he has been running for the City Council in District 4 and appears to have won, so he is looking forward to stepping up into that new position.
