## LINDA MAR PUMP STATION TEMPORARY WET WEATHER PUMPING AND STORAGE

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (Pacifica, CA) – This week, the City's contractor, Rain For Rent, will begin removing the Linda Mar Pump Station Temporary Wet Weather Pumping And Storage project. The project consisted of 2 portable pumps and 16 tanks, which had a capacity of 336,000 gallons, and was used to pump and temporarily store wet weather sewage overflow, preventing the potential for release of untreated sewage.

The system was installed in December 2018 and will be removed from Linda Mar Beach this week. It was a temporary system to ensure no releases of untreated sewage while the Wet Weather Equalization Project continues to be constructed. The parking lot adjacent to Linda Mar Pump Station will temporarily be closed from May 22 to May 24 and will reopen for Memorial Day Weekend starting on May 25.
