

Pacifica's Fats, Oils and Grease Program

Pursuant to the California State Water Resources Control Board and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board general waste discharge requirement, the City of Pacifica must administer as part of its Sewer System Management Plan (SSMP) a Fats, Oils, and Grease (F.O.G.) Program. The Waste Water Department administers the F.O.G. Program through various activities like grease interceptor inspections of food establishments, closed circuit television inspections of known F.O.G. producing areas, and through a rigorous public outreach effort. The specific details of the F.O.G. Program and the legal authority outlined in the City's Municipal Code may be found in the F.O.G. Program element of the SSMP which may be found here: http://www.cityofpacifica.org/depts/wwt/waste_water_collection/sanitarymp.asp.
