FILE NO. 2021-024 FOR SIGN PERMIT S-135-21, filed by David Ford, to establish a master sign program for an existing multi-unit commercial building at 580 Crespi Drive (APN 022-162-390). The master sign program includes establishment of a freestanding sign. Recommended California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) status: Class 1 Categorical Exemption, CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 "Existing Facilities" and Class 11 Categorical Exemption, CEQA Guidelines Section 15311 "Accessory Structures"; and

FILE NO. 2022-008 FOR TEXT AMENDMENT TA-121-22, initiated by the City of Pacifica, to consider extension of Title 9, Chapter 5 – Growth Control of the Pacifica Municipal Code, by specifically amending Pacifica Municipal Code ("PMC") Section 9-5.11 [Termination], and making clarifying amendments to PMC Section 9-5.07 [Agricultural Land] and PMC Section 9-5.08 [Hillside Protection]. The text amendment to be discussed would affect property citywide. The Planning Commission will consider the text amendment and make a recommendation to the City Council. Recommended CEQA Status: Common sense exemption, CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
