Planting Guidelines for California Natives

We're so excited you're joining us in restoring the beauty and ecological sustainability of Pacifica through planting California Natives. Please reference the below guidelines for the basic principles of planting California Natives in your home, business, or community garden. Happy planting!

- The Beautification Advisory Committee

BEFORE PLANTING

- 1. If possible, water the area to be planted two or more days prior to make sure moisture is in the soil before planting. Be sure not to water the day of, or the day before planting.
- 2. Water all planting material before planting. Preferably the day before planting.

PLANTING

- 3. Dig hole 3 times as wide as the root ball, but not deeper. Plant should fit in the hole with the top of the root ball ½" to 1" higher than the top of the soil.
- 4. After removing the plant from its container, gently pull the roots apart to encourage the roots to grow outward.
- 5. For California native plants amend soil with sandy soil mix if needed, or just use domestic soil to back fill the planting whole. Do not use any compost or fertilizers.
- 6. Bury the root ball by pushing soil into the planting hole. Push down the soil firmly with your hands to fill voids in the planting hole.

AFTER PLANTING

- 7. If installing a drip system, make sure there is an emitter (where the water flows out) on top of the root ball of the plant, or place emitter on the high side of a plant, an inch above the root ball.
- 8. Apply 3" of mulch to all planting areas, covering any drip system pipe. Keep mulch a few inches from the base of the plant, but make sure root ball is covered.
- 9. Water plants generously after planting.
